Follow The Dream empowers Indigenous students to successfully complete their secondary schooling and pursue their chosen post-school pathway and aspirations

Achieving academic success lies at the heart of Follow The Dream. Students have access to individualised after-school tutoring and mentoring that supports achievement across all areas of the curriculum. Personalised Learning Plans guide students in achieving their learning goals and pursuing their post-school aspirations.

Students experience a range of opportunities that enrich learning and broaden horizons and celebrate culture. The learning support and experiences offered at each site reflect the needs and interests of students and the communities where they operate. Program experiences typically include:

- subject and career counselling
- cultural acknowledgement and celebrations exploring post school workplace, training and higher education options
- study skills seminars
- well-being support
- developing general capabilities and
- engaging with local industry and community groups

Follow The Dream encourages students to **Dream Big** with purpose in a setting which has a sense of belonging. On completing school, students are well prepared to successfully embark on career pathways identify as leaders and be role models for their peers, families and communities

How Follow The Dream works

Programs are school based and led by a Program Coordinator who with a team of tutors plan and deliver individualised or small group support.

Tutoring is available up to 4 afternoons per week.

Assistance may include ensuring completion of assessment tasks, consolidating understanding of key concepts, addressing specific learning needs and developing skills and capabilities.

Students engage in a broad range of opportunities and experiences including camps, excursions, visitors and projects that motivate and appeal to their interests.
